Gujarat Police Act, 1951.

No.GG/GUJ/86/2016/MHK/1011/2222/C: In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (b) section 5 of the Gujarat Police Act, 1951 (Bom. XXII of 1951) and in supersession of all the rules made in this behalf, the Government of Gujarat hereby makes the following rules to provide for regulating recruitment to the post of Intelligence Officer, Class III, in the subordinate service of the Police Department, namely:-

- 1. These rules may be called the Intelligence Officer, Class III, in the Police Department Recruitment Rules, 2016.
- 2. Appointment to the post of Intelligence Officer, Class III, in the subordinate service of the Police Department shall be made either, -
 - (a) by promotion of a person of proved merit and efficiency from amongst the persons who,-
 - (i) have worked for not less than five years in the cadre of Assistant Intelligence Officer, Class III, in the subordinate service of the Police Department,-
 - (ii) have passed the departmental examination prescribed for promotion to the post of Intelligence Officer, Class III;
 - (iii) have passed the qualifying examination for computer knowledge in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Computer Competency Training and Examination Rules, 2006; or
 - (b) by direct selection; or
 - (c) by temporary transfer on deputation from the willing persons working on the cadre of Police Sub Inspectors Armed and Unarmed (not exceeding 55 years of age)

from the Gujarat State Police Force and Gujarat State Reserve Police Force and who possess the educational qualifications as prescribed in clause (b) of rule 4 for direct selection.

- 3. Appointment by direct selection and by promotion and by transfer on deputation basis shall be made in the ratio of 6:3:1, respectively.
- 4. To be eligible for appointment by direct selection to the post mentioned in clause (b) of rule 2 candidate shall,-
 - (a) not be less than 21 years of age and not be more than 35 years of age:

Provided that the upper age limit may be relaxed in favour of a candidate of a Scheduled Caste, Scheduled Tribe, Socially and Educationally Backward Class, Economically weaker Section and in favour of a Woman in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967:

Provided further that the upper age limit may be relexed in favour of a candidate who is already in the Government service of Government of Gujarat in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967:

Provided also that the upper age limit may also be relaxed to the extent of three years in favour of a candidate who is working as a constable, class III or head constable, class III or Assistant sub-inspector, class-III, in the subordinate service of Police Department.

(b) possess a Bachelor's degree obtained from any of the Universities established or incorported by or under the Central or a State Act in India or any other educational institution recognised as such or declared to be a deemed as a University under section 3 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956; or possess an equivalent qualification recognised by the Government;

- (c) possess the minimum requisite standards of physique as specified in Apendix 'A' appended to these rules;
- (d) possess the basic knowledge of computer application as prescribed in the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rule, 1967; and
- (e) possess adequate knowledge of Gujarati or Hindi or both.
- 5. The provisions of rule 9 A of the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967 shall be applicable in respect of a candidate appointed by direct selection.
- 6. The candidate appointed in accordance with rule 5 shall, during the stipulated period of service on contractual basis require to undergo police training and pass the post-training examination in accordance with the rules prescribed by the Government.
- 7. The candidate appointed in accordance with rule 5 shall have to possess valid light/heavy motor vehicle driving license within stipulated period of service on contractual basis.
- The candidate appointed in accordance with rule 5 shall, after regular appointment require to pass the departmental examination in accordance with the rules prescribed by the Government.
- 9. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall require to undergo such training and pass such

examination as may be prescribed by the Government from time to time.

10. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall require to furnish a security and a surety bond in such form, for such amount and for such period as may be prescribed by the Government from time to time.
